Make checks payable to the Union University Church with “Senior Foundation” in the memo line.

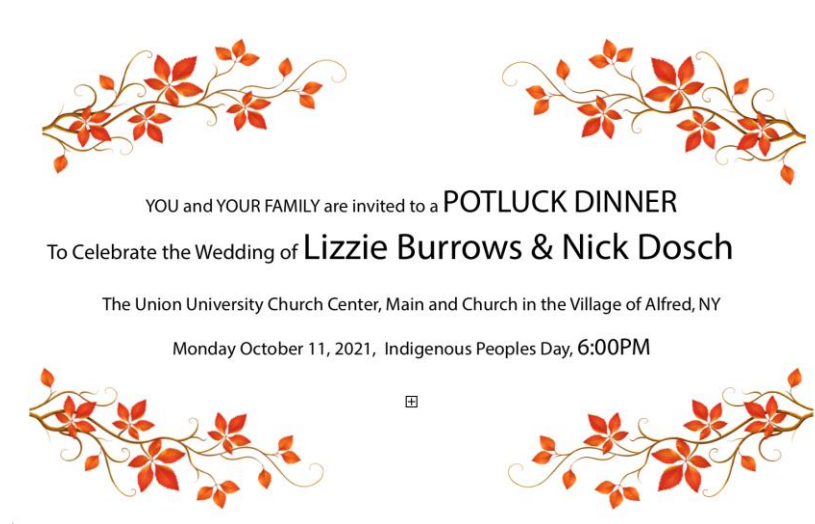
Add Your Name to the List of UUC Members:
